Registering Upward

A player may be registered for a camp older than their age by as much as one year.

A player may not be registered downward.

Late Registration

Space permitting, late registrations will be accepted at a prorated fee until the start of the 3rd morning of any particular camp.

Volunteer Appreciation

Any member of a registering player's family who has volunteered at least 30 hours (without pay or other compensation) in support of their local community association since September 2013 is eligible for a camp(s) fee discount upon request. Contact the YAS Camps Director prior to registering.

Bursary Fund

YAS annually receives grants and tax-deductible donations to its bursary fund. Awards from the YAS Bursary Fund assist those who cannot afford all their YAS fees. Since 1996, over \$355,000.00 in bursaries has been awarded. A bursary inquiry must be made by a parent, guardian or other adult extended family member at least two weeks before the camp(s) of interest and prior to registration.

Bursary inquiries and awards are confidential and handled only by the YAS Camps Director.

Every graduate from a YAS bantam and senior camp held during 2014 is automatically invited to register to be placed on a tournament team.

If they wish to do so, they may each register one or two guests for the tournament who:

(b) have not attended any sports camp held in Regina or Saskatoon during 2014.

Every graduate of a past YAS camp who is unable to attend a YAS 2014 camp is also automatically invited if they are age 13 to 16 as of June 30th, and have not attended any other basketball camp in Regina or Saskatoon since they graduated from YAS.

Summer Basketball School

Each year, YAS administrators and instructors survey leading high school and college coaches in order to identify the current skills emphasis needed among young players. Input from those surveyed is incorporated into YAS summer basketball camps.

YAS was founded by champion high school coaches in 1975.

Since then, 12,159 players from 271 communities have graduated from YAS summer basketball camps. They returned to their regular schools to excel in basketball and other sports.



Each summer, YAS Head Coach Hall brings the "quick and smart" basketball style common at American high schools and colleges to YAS camps. A retired teacher, principal and college professor, Hall is also a builder and 8-year President of the 100+ team Regina Community Basketball Association (RCBA), former coach of secondary school teams in Victoria, and champion senior teams at Miller High School and Balfour Collegiate in Regina. He is a scholar in the fields of learning, communications, and attention-focus training in youth sports.

"Of all the skills that are taught in sports, one of the most important and the least learned is how to focus one's attention under game pressure - how to identify and block out distractions. This fundamental skill is not automatic. It can be and has to be taught and learned. Without this skill, excellent athletes consistently underperform.
