### **Infill Development & Urban Planning**

The City of Saskatoon is developing a Neighbourhood Infill Strategy, concerning Infill within built-up areas of the City. This is of particular concern to VVCA, especially given the growth of the University's College Quarter development, arguably the City's largest infill experiment. After an initlal Public Workshop in December, 2012, the City is currently seeking input on recommendations for a draft strategy, addressing the following:

- · development standards and architectural guidelines
- site design including consideration for garage/garden suites
- building design
- streetscape and landscape design

It has scheduled a Community Conversation, as follows:

#### **URBAN PLANNING EVENTS**

The Regional and Urban Planning (RUP) program of the College of Geography and Planning at the University of Saskatchewan has scheduled an exciting series of urban planning events for the week of March 18 to 22, 2013

The RUP has a Planner in Residence program. In 2011 New York City planner Cynthia Nikitin was the first Planner in Residence. The second Planner in Residence program will run from March 18 to 22, 2013. Mr Larry Beasley of Vancouver has accepted an offer to be PiR for 2013. Mr. Beasley is former co-Director of Planning for Vancouver and is credited for the "Vancouverism" model of urban planning. He is now a planning consultant working in all parts of the world, including Moscow and Dubai. During the week of March 18, 2013, Mr Beasley will provide guest lectures in Geography and Planning at the University of Saskatchewan, give a talk at City Hall, meet with RUP students, critique student design and capstone projects, offer an evening public talk at the Roxy Theatre (March 20, 2013 at 7pm), and end the week as Keynote Speaker to Curio-City, the first ever RUP studentled planning conference, on March 22/23, 2013 at the University of Saskatchewan. It will be a fabulous and busy week for planning in Saskatoon.
